Agawa Canyon Railroad (ON) August 12 – 14, 2025 (Tues – Thurs)

Great Lakes Railcars, Inc. is hosting a 3-day, 430-mile, motor car excursion on the Agawa Canyon Railroad through the beautiful northern Ontario wilderness from Tuesday, August 12 through Thursday, August 14, 2025. The trip will start in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario (set-on Monday afternoon, August 11, 2025, between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.) and will run north ~165 miles to Hawk Junction, ON, on Day 1. Day 2 will be a roundtrip between Hawk Junction and Canyon (~104 R/T, with 2 hours to explore the Canyon). Day 3 will then be the return trip from Hawk Jct. to Sault Ste. Marie (~165 miles).
